1 Travelling Dua & Boarding a Vehicle

Before Leaving Home

بسم الله، توكلت على الله، ولا حول ولا قوة إلا بالله

Bismillah, tawakkaltu 'alallah, wa la hawla wa la quwwata illa billah.

Meaning: I begin with the Name of Allah; I trust in Allah; there is no altering of conditions but by the Power of Allah.

When Boarding the Plane

بسم الله، والحمد لله، سبحان الذي سخر لنا هذا وما كنا له
بمقرنين، وإنّا إلى ربنا لمنقلبون

Bismillah, walhamdulillah. Subhanal-ladzi sakh-khara lana hadza wa ma kunna lahu muqrinin. Wa inna ila Rabbina lamun-qalibun.

Meaning: In the name of Allah and all praise is for Allah. How perfect He is, the one who has placed this (transport) at our service, and we ourselves would not have been capable of that, and to our Lord is our final destiny.

2 Arrival in Saudi Arabia

أعوذ بكلمات الله التامات من شر ما خلق

A'udzu bikalimatillahit-tammati min sharri ma khalaq.

Meaning: I seek refuge in Allah's perfect words from every evil (that has been created).

3

Dua at Miqat

سبحان الله، ولا إله إلا الله، والله أكبر

Subhan Allah, La ilāha ill Allah, Allāhu Akbar.

Meaning: Glory be to Allah, there is no god but Allah, Allah is Most Great.

Entering Ihram Intention

لبيك اللهم حجًا

Labbaika Allahumma Hajjan.

Meaning: Here I am, O Allah, for Hajj.

After Wearing Ihram Garments

الحمد لله رب العالمين، وصلى الله على سيدنا محمد وعلى
آله الطاهرين

*Alhamdulillah rabilalameen wa salla Allahu ala saedena muhammad wa ala alehe
altahereen.*

Meaning: Praise be to Allah, Lord of the Worlds, and peace and blessings be upon our
Prophet Muhammad and his pure family.

Entering Ihram Dua

اللهم حجةً لا رياء فيها ولا سمعة

Allahumma hajjatun la riyā'a fiha, wa lā sum'ata.

Meaning: O Allah, a Hajj in which there is no showing off nor reputation sought.

لا إله إلا الله والله أكبر، اللهم أنت السلام ومنك السلام

*Laa ilaaha illAllahu wallahu Akbar. Allahumma Antas Salaam, wa minkas Salaam,

Meaning: There is no God but Allah. Allah is the greatest. O Allah, You are Peace and from You is peace. So grant us life, O our Lord, with peace and security.

Meaning: O Allah, increase this house in honour, esteem, respect and reverence. And increase those who honour and respect it, of those who perform Hajj or 'Umrah, in honour, respect, esteem and piety.

Intention for Tawaf

اللهم إني أريد طواف بيتك الحرام فيسره لي وتقبله مني

Allāhumma innī urīdu l-ṭawwafa baytika l-ḥarāmi fa yassirhu lī wa taqabbalhu minnī.

Meaning: O Allah, I intend to perform the Tawaf of the Sacred Mosque, so accept it from me and make it easy for me.

Beginning Each Round

بسم الله والله أكبر والله الحمد

Bismillahi Allahu Akbar wa lillahil hamd.

Meaning: I start in the name of Allah, Allah is the Greatest, and all praise belongs to Him.

Talbiyah During Tawaf

لبيك اللهم لبيك، لبيك لا شريك لك لبيك، إن الحمد والنعمة
لك والملك لا شريك لك

*Labbayka Allāhumma labbayk. Labbayk lā shareeka laka labbayk. Inna al-ḥamda, wa n-
'imata, Laka wal mulk. Lā shareeka lak.*

Meaning: Here I am, O Allah, here I am. You have no partner, here I am. Verily, all praise and blessings are Yours, and all autonomy. You have no partner.

7 Al-Hajar Al-Aswad (Black Stone) Duas

Between Rukn Al-Yamani & Al-Hajar Al-Aswad

ربنا آتنا في الدنيا حسنة وفي الآخرة حسنة وقنا عذاب النار

Rabbānā ātinā fi-d-dunyā ḥasanah wa fil-ākhirati ḥasanah wa qinā 'adhāba-n-Nār.

Meaning: Our Lord, grant us good in this world and good in the Hereafter, and protect us from the torment of the Fire.

While Kissing Al-Hajar Al-Aswad

بسم الله الله أكبر والله الحمد

Bismillahi Allahu Akbar Wa lillahil Hamd.

Meaning: In the name of Allah, Allah is the greatest. All Praises belong to Allah.

After Kissing Al-Hajar Al-Aswad

سبحان الله والحمد لله ولا إله إلا الله والله أكبر ولا حول ولا
قوة إلا بالله العلي العظيم، الصلوات والسلام على رسول

O Allah, indeed this house is Your house, this sanctuary is Your sanctuary, this protection is Your protection, the enslaved people are Your slaves, and I am Your slave and the son of Your slave. This place is a means of protection from Hell-fire, so protect my flesh, blood and skin from Hell-fire.

اللهم يا رب البيت العتيق، أعتق رقابنا ورقاب آبائنا وأمهاتنا
من النار، يا ذا الجود والكرم والفضل واليمن والعطاء والإحسان،

Allahumma Ya Rabbal baitil 'Ateeq. A'tiq riqaabana wa riqaba aabaaina wa ummahaatinaa minan Naar. Ya zal-joodi wal karami wal fadli wal manni wal 'ataai wal Ihsaan. Allahumma ahsin 'aqibatana filumuri kulliha wa ajirna min khizyi-ddunia wa 'azaabil Aakhirah.

Meaning: O Allah, O Lord of the ancient house, please protect our necks and the necks of our fathers and mothers from the Fire. O owner of goodness, generosity, grace and blessings. O Allah! Grant us a good end in all our affairs, and protect us from disgrace in the worldly life and torment in the hereafter.

Near Rukne Iraq

Meaning: O Allah, I ask for your protection against doubt, polytheism, schism, hypocrisy, bad morality, and ill-return in the family, property and children.

Near Mizab Al-Rahma

إلا وجهك، واسقنا من حوض نبيك محمدا صلى الله عليه

*Allahumma Azillana tahta zilli 'arshika yawma laa zilla illa zilluk, wa laa baaqiya illaa
wajhuk. Wasqina min hawdi nabiyyina Muhammadin Sallallahu' Alaihi wa sallam sharbatan
hanee'atan maree'atan laa nazma'u ba'daha abadaa. Birahmatika ya arhamar Raahimeen.*

Meaning: O Allah, put me under the shadow of Your Throne on the Day when there will be no shadow except the shadow of Your Throne and give me to drink from the pool of our master Muhammad a delicious and sating drink after which I shall never get thirsty, by Your mercy, O the most merciful one.

Near Rukne Al-Shami

اللهم اجعله حجا مبرورا وسعيا مشكورا وذنباً مغفورا وتجربة
لن تبور يا عالم ما في الصدور أخرجنا يا الله من الظلمات
إلى النور

*Allahummaj'alha Hajjan Mabroorah, wa sa'yan mashkoora, wa zanban maghfoora, wa
tijaaratan tan taboor. Ya 'aalima maa fis sudoor, akhrijnee Ya Allāhu minaz zulumaati ilan
noor.*

Meaning: O Allah, make this a Hajj which is accepted, with an accepted effort, (my) sin
which is pardoned, a commerce which is not lost. O, the one who knows what is hidden in
(our) chests, O Allah, bring us out from darknesses into the light.

Near Rukne Yamani

اللهم إني أسألك العفو والعافية في ديني ودنياي والآخرة

Allahumma innee as'aluka al afwa wa al' aafiyata fi deeni wad dunya wal 'aakhirah.

Meaning: O Allah, grant me pardon and safety from danger and sin in this world and in the
hereafter.

Between Rukne Yamani and Hajre Aswad

ربنا آتنا في الدنيا حسنة وفي الآخرة حسنة وقنا عذاب النار.
وأدخلنا الجنة مع الأبرار يا عزيز يا غفار يا رب العالمين

*Rabbana 'aatina fid dunya hasanatan wa fil aakhirati hasanatan wa qinaa 'azaban naar.
Wa adkhiinal jannata ma'al abaar. Ya 'Azeezu ya ghaffaaru, ya Rabbal 'aalameen.*

Meaning: Our Lord! Give us goodness in this world and goodness in the hereafter. And
save us from the torment of the Fire. And admit us into your paradise with the pious ones,
O, The All-Mighty, O, The Forgiver, O, the Lord of the Universe.

بسم الله والحمد لله والصلاة والسلام على رسول الله، اللهم

*Bismillah wal hamdulillah. Wassalatu wassalamu ala rasulillah. Allahumma innee as'aluka

Meaning: In the name of Allah. All praises belong to Allah. Peace and blessings of Allah be upon the Messenger of Allah. O Allah, I beg you for beneficial knowledge, good deeds, abundant sustenance and a cure from all diseases.

Upon Reaching Safa (Quranic Verse)

Meaning: Indeed, (the hills of) Safa and Marwah are among the symbols of Allah. So whoever makes the major or minor pilgrimage to the (Sacred) House, let them walk between (the two hills). And whoever does good willingly, Allah is truly Appreciative, All-Knowing.

Facing the Ka'bah from Safa

الله أكبر، الله أكبر، الله أكبر ولله الحمد. لا إله إلا الله

On Tops of Safa and Marwah

Meaning: There is no god but Allah. He is alone, with no partner. To Him alone belong all
autonomy and all praise. He gives life and gives death. He is over all things All-Powerful.
He fulfilled His promise, supported His slave and defeated the confederates alone.

Between Green Lights in Sa'i

Meaning: Oh Allah, forgive us and have mercy on us. You are the greatest and the most
kind.

11 Day of Arafah

12 Muzdalifah Dua

Meaning: Allah is the Greatest. There is no one worthy of worship but Allah. Allah is One.

13 Throwing Pebbles at Jamrat

Recite with each stone thrown:

Allāhu Akbar.

Meaning: Allah is the Greatest.

14 Slaughtering an Animal

بسم الله والله أكبر، اللهم منك ولك ، اللهم تقبل مني

Bismillahi wa Allāhu Akbar, Allahumma minka wa laka, Allahumma taqabbal minni.

Meaning: With the Name of Allah, Allah is the Most Great! O Allah, from You and to You. O Allah, accept it from me.

15 Al-Tashreeq Dua

Meaning: In the name of Allah and Peace and Salutations upon the messenger of Allah. O Allah, forgive my sins and open for me the gate of Your mercy.

Meaning: O Allah! This is the Sacred Precinct of Your Prophet, so make it a protection for me from the Fire and security from punishment and a bad reckoning.

Meaning: Our Lord, forgive our parents and us and have mercy upon them as they have looked after me in my childhood.

Meaning: Our Lord, grant us from among our wives and offspring comfort to our eyes and make us an example for the righteous.

Meaning: My Lord, make me an establisher of prayer, and [many] from my descendants. Our Lord, and accept my supplication. Our Lord, forgive me and my parents and the believers on the Day the account is established.

لا إله إلا الله العظيم الحليم، لا إله إلا الله رب العرش
العظيم، لا إله إلا الله رب السموات ورب الأرض ورب العرش
الكريم

*Laa ilaaha il'lal laahul 'Azeem, Laa ilaaha il'lal laahu Rab'bul Arshil Azeem, Laa ilaaha il'lal
laahu Rab'bus Samawaati wal Ardi wa Rab'bul Arshil Kareem.*

Meaning: No one has the right to be worshipped, but Allah is Incomparably Great, the Compassionate. None has the right to be worshipped, but Allah is the Lord of the Mighty Throne. None has the right to be worshipped, but Allah is the Lord of the heavens, the earth, and the Honourable Throne.

ربنا لا تزغ قلوبنا بعد إذ هديتنا وهب لنا من لدنك رحمةً
إنك أنت الوهاب

*Rabbanaa laa tuzig Quloobanaa ba'da iz hadaitanaa wah ab lanaa min ladunka rahmatan

Meaning: Our Lord, let not our hearts deviate after You have guided us and granted us Your mercy. Indeed, You are the Bestower.

Faatiras Samaawaati wa ard. Anta waliyyee fid dunya wal aakhirah. Tawaffanee musliman wa alhiqnee bissaaliheen.

Meaning: O Creator of the heavens and the earth, You are my patron in this world and the hereafter! Make me die in submission to You (as a Muslim) and admit me with the righteous.

اللهم اغفر لحينا وميتنا وشاهدنا وغائبنا وصغيرنا وكبيرنا وذكرنا
وأئتنا، اللهم من أحييته منا فأحيه على الإسلام ومن توفيته

Meaning: O Allah, forgive our living and our dead, those present and those absent, our young and our old, our males and our females. O Allah, whomever of us You cause to live, let him live in Islam, and whoever You cause to die, let him die in a state of faith.

18 Dua for Return

آيبن، تائبون، ساجدون، لربنا حامدون

Ayibun, ta'ibun, 'abidun, sajjidun, lirabbina hamidun.

Meaning: We return, repentant, worshipping, prostrating and praising our Lord.

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Frequently Asked Questions About Hajj Duas

Is it permissible to supplicate during Hajj in English?

Yes, it is completely fine to make supplications in any language you speak and feel comfortable in. However, many Muslims choose to recite certain traditional supplications from the Sunnah in Arabic during specific rituals of Hajj and Umrah.

What should one pray for their friends?

One should pray for their friends by asking for whatever they desire and requesting good for them in both this world (Dunya) and the hereafter (Akhira).

Is it necessary to memorise the supplications for Hajj?

No, it is not necessary to memorise them. You can read the supplications from a booklet or on your phone.

Is it a must to recite the Hajj duas in Arabic?

While it is not necessary to recite them in Arabic, it is preferable to do so.

Are the Hajj supplications different for men and women?

No, the Hajj supplications are the same for both men and women.

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
